New Homes Bonus Scheme 2015

Under the New Homes Bonus scheme, the Government currently makes a payment to local authorities for every home added to their council tax and the District Council receive this fund which is then apportioned to Parish Councils.

This year Chichester City Council has been allocated £170,000 for community projects. Does your community have a project that needs funding? If so, please read on.

Guidelines and the New Homes Bonus Application Form are available from the Reception Desk at the Council House, North Street, Chichester or they can be downloaded from a link on the City Council's website www.chichestercity.gov.uk.

Your first point of contact should be your City Councillor who will 'champion' your project.

New Homes Bonus applications need to be submitted to Chichester City Council by Friday 3 July 2015.

A presentation of the proposed project will be required at the Special Chichester City Council Meeting on Wednesday 15 July 2015.

If your project is supported by Chichester City Council the application will be submitted to Chichester District Council to meet their deadline of Friday 31 July 2015 and a decision will be made by Chichester District Council in September 2015.
