New Homes Bonus Scheme 2017

On behalf of various local organisations, Chichester City Council submitted four New Homes Bonus Applications to the District Council's New Homes Bonus Scheme and three of the applications submitted were approved as follows :

New Park Community & Arts Association (enhancement of community facilities)	£24,820
Florence Park (provision of a disabled swing)	£15,000
South Downs Planetarium (installation of solar panels)	£20,000
