Civic, Heritage & Young Citizens' Awards 2015

Nomination Forms are available for the City Council's annual Civic, Heritage & Young Citizens' Awards.

Civic Awards are awarded to people who have contributed their services to the well-being of the City.

The Heritage Awards are for any buildings that have been restored, redeveloped, etc, within the past 12 months and which have enhanced or made an impact on the City.

The Young Citizens' Award is for young people under the age of 18 years who have shown heroic, caring and citizenship roles within the City.

Nominations for Blue Plaques to commemorate famous people or events connected with Chichester buildings are also being sought.
