New Homes Bonus Scheme 2015

On behalf of various local organisations, Chichester City Council submitted eight New Homes Bonus Applications to the District Council's New Homes Bonus Scheme and five of the applications submitted were approved as follows :

South Downs Planetarium : Upgrading exhibition and display areas	£25,000
SPRING for Youth at Swanfield Community Centre : Creation of dedicated youth area	£25,000
New Park Centre : Upgrading WC facilities	£13,500
Chichester Rugby Football Club : New kitchen equipment	£20,000
Chichester Boys Club : Replacement roof project	£25,000
