New Homes Bonus Scheme 2016

On behalf of various local organisations, Chichester City Council submitted six New Homes Bonus Applications to the District Council's New Homes Bonus Scheme and five of the applications submitted were approved as follows :

Chichester Boys Club : Replacement roof project	£15,000
St Wilfrid's Hospice : DREAMBUILDING project	£25,000
Regnum Guide Hall : Provision of new kitchen	£20,000
CCDT : Voluntary Sector Hub at the Water Tower, Graylingwell	£20,000
City Council : Landscaping Works for the Garden of Reflection & Reconciliation	£10,000



Chichester's Annual Remembrance Sunday Service and Parade will take place on Sunday 13 November

The Parade will form up in East Street and march to the War Memorial in Litten Gardens

The Mayor, Chichester City Councillors, Chairmen of Chichester District Council and West Sussex County Council will be in attendance for the 11 o'clock service



The Mayor of Chichester will be at the City Cross on Armistice Day at 11 o'clock to observe a two minutes silence for the Royal British Legion Act of Remembrance



The Market Cross stonework cleaning and restoration works are progressing well and are on schedule. Moss and lichen have been removed and a shelter-coating will be applied to some of the stonework. All the work is being overseen by Historic England.

The City Council's Property Team have been busy refurbishing the benches and relocating the Interpretation Board to a more prominent area in Litten Gardens

The City Centre flower tower bases and the Cathedral Beds will be planted up soon ready for the Winter/Spring display. Over 200 crocus bulbs and 100 daffodil bulbs will be planted at Northgate.
