




Presumption in favour of sustainable development

Public participation – "us" and "them"









S 38(6) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

 In the determination of planning applications, decisions must be made in accordance with the development plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.

• The "Development Plan" =

Local Plan and any adopted documents + Neighbourhood Plans


NPPF – Government policy = material consideration

Neighbourhood Plans









Referendum

If 50% or more of votes cast are "YES" = Plan adopted.







Neighbourhood Plans can include

- Planning policies must be evidenced
- Infrastructure projects
- Aspirations/statements of public consensus





CIL – Community Infrastructure Levy





Developers pay £120/sqm – approx. £14,400 per house

No Neighbourhood Plan = 15% to Parish = £2,160




Neighbourhood Plan = 25% to Parish = £3,600

Difference = approx. £1,500/house or £100,000/70 houses = £1,000,000/700 houses






Neighbourhood Plan – population 27,000

• 1,669 responses – initial consultation 6.2%

Adopted Local Plan – population 114,000

- 968 responses strategic growth options 0.9%
- 610 responses housing 0.5%
- 4,968 responses key policies preferred approach 4.4%
- 119 responses key policies pre- submission 119 0.1%


