You will need to:

- be a not for profit making organisation
- be Chichester focused, either through geographic location or target group
- provide a simple Business Plan outlining why a grant would help your organisation. Additional information is required for larger Grants.
- provide your latest Audited Accounts or an Income & Expenditure Sheet for the last financial year

Small Grants are available for under £500 or larger Grants for over £500.
