

## Proposal for Civic Awards Ceremony Format – February 2025

## **Recommendations:**

That the adopted policies in the Civic & Ceremonial Functions Review (Meeting of 7<sup>th</sup> October 2024, minute ref.42) be implemented:

- 1. A rolling five-year default invitation should be introduced for previous recipients to future ceremonies, with a limit of two representatives for each previous Community Award winner, to ensure that attendees remain at a manageable number and to challenge the concept of the "old boys club"
- 2. Priority for attendance should be given to the current year's recipients and their guests before those of previous years.
- 3. The event should be restricted to a maximum of 90\* guests, including Councillors and staff.
- 4. Implement a system offering a complimentary drink upon arrival at Council events, with a paid bar model for additional drinks. All proceeds from the paid bar will be donated to the mayor's charity.
- 5. Transition from waiter-served events with canapés to a buffet-style arrangement to significantly reduce costs and minimize waste.
- 6. These recommendations aim to enhance fiscal responsibility while maintaining the integrity of the Council's civic functions

The \*90 guest limit does not include the Award Winners and their guests.
